

Go Teams in Action

From January through June 2025, Kids Alive has sent 35 Go Teams, mobilizing nearly 400 volunteers through 20 partner organizations to serve alongside our staff across the globe.

These trips bring encouragement, energy, and blessing to the children in our programs while strengthening long-term partnerships. Many teams are made up of students from churches or Christian schools, giving young people hands-on mission experience. A growing trend has also been parent-child teams—like the father-son and mother-daughter groups from Wheaton Christian Grammar School who served at four sites in the Dominican Republic. These experiences create lasting memories and spark spiritual growth for both generations.

MVPC'S MUSIC & DANCE CAMP AT PALO BLANCO IN THE DOMINICAN REPUBLIC

For more than 20 years, Go Teams from Moraga Valley Presbyterian Church (MVPC) have been a faithful presence at Kids Alive sites in the Dominican Republic and Peru. Since sending their first team in 2010, they've returned 27 times—20 to the DR and 7 to Peru—building lasting friendships, encouraging staff, and blessing children far beyond a single trip.

This summer, a group of MVPC high school students and adults brought something special to Palo Blanco School: a week-long music and dance camp. The team included a worship leader, ballet dancers, and several musicians. Using the gifts God gave them, they designed activities that reflected their passions—teaching scales on the recorder, leading worship songs, guiding ballet lessons, acting out Bible skits, and even helping children build their own drums. Each afternoon, classrooms rang with music, laughter, and joy. The week concluded with a

lively performance for classmates, parents, and neighbors—a celebration of creativity and community. Team leader Stacy shared, "My highlight of the week was the final performance—watching the kids all be so proud of what they learned and seeing them perform."

For many of these children, access to music and instruments is rare. This camp opened the door to new passions and gave them a chance to discover talents they never knew they had.

But perhaps the greatest gift of MVPC's decades of service is the deep, ongoing relationships. Returning team members greet children they sponsor as Student Champions, reconnect with former students, and encourage staff they've served alongside year after year. These bonds remind children that they are part of a global family that truly knows and loves them.

The week also reflected the beauty of the Body of Christ working across cultures. "I benefited by working with the Palo team and creating something special for the kids with Spanish and English speakers," Stacy reflected. Even with language barriers, God provided understanding, unity, and shared joy as the team and staff served side by side.

In addition to the camp, the team helped with construction projects, listened to student testimonies, and poured encouragement into teachers and staff. These moments, woven together, form more than just a week's impact—they are a testimony to God's faithfulness through long-term partnership.

With her Champions walking beside her, Esther completed high school in 2017 and pursued her dream of becoming a nurse. After years of perseverance, she graduated in 2022—and just a year later, she returned to serve with Kids Alive Haiti, this time as staff. Today, she provides medical care to children and families while sharing the same love of Christ that once transformed her own life.

This year, new Champions are joining us in bringing light and hope to children who might otherwise feel forgotten. With your partnership and advocacy, we can ensure every student is fully supported—reminding them they are seen, valued, and not alone.

Alex Found Belonging and New Life in Christ

gone forever. When he visited his father on weekends, the house never felt like home. Many times, Alex spent long hours sitting outside on the stairs, unwanted and unseen. For 15 years, he lived with the ache of loss and rejection.

But when Alex came to Kids Alive Lebanon. Dar El Awlad, he discovered something new-safety, care, and a place where he was wanted. At Dar El Awlad, Alex found staff who believed in him, mentors who guided him, and a family of boys who became his brothers. Here, he began to understand what it means to be loved and valued, no matter his past.

WHAT'S HAPPENING IN LEBANON:


- Two brothers who joined our residential program back in 2015 have now graduated high school and are preparing to enter university—a powerful step toward a brighter future.
- A new special education coordinator is now strengthening our school team, equipping teachers to meet each student's unique learning needs.
- A part-time psychomotor therapist recently joined the team, and boys are already showing improvement in focus and attention.
- Our social worker is walking closely with families in the Lighthouse Program, providing care, follow-up, and training for Syrian refugees and women in vulnerable communities.
- At the end of the academic year, we gave the girls from the New Horizons Centre in the South a joyful trip to Beirut—games, activities, and lunch at Dar El Awlad—a welcome break from the harsh realities of war near their homes.
- Students also enjoyed a three-day Bible camp filled with games, crafts, verse memorization, and fellowship—celebrating a year of hard work.
- Around 50 women attended a "Rise Up!" summer retreat, most from non-Christian backgrounds, and heard messages of hope and encouragement.
- In August, a medical team led by Dr. Ray Hachem partnered with us to provide check-ups for our students and their parents, distribute medicines and vitamins, and vaccinate residential boys.



Patrick Found Hope and a Future

For Patrick*, childhood often meant going without—without meals, without school supplies, and without the steady love of a parent. After losing his mother, the person he depended on most, his father walked away, leaving Patrick and his siblings behind. His grandmother stepped in with courage and love, but with limited resources and failing health, she struggled to meet even his basic needs.

Everything began to change when Patrick was enrolled at Kids Alive's Hall Mead School in Kenya. Here he found more than an education—he discovered safety, daily meals, emotional care, and spiritual support. Through Restorative Education and holistic programs focused on good health, spiritual growth, and family strengthening, Patrick began to flourish.

With therapy, consistent encouragement, and opportunities to grow in his faith, Patrick's healing journey took root. His teachers saw his confidence grow, his academic performance improve, and his joy return. He made new friends and is now actively participating in spiritual activities, learning to place his trust in God.

Today, Patrick dreams of becoming a teacher so that he can inspire others the same way he has been inspired. His grandmother, still facing challenges, says she no longer feels alone—because the Kids Alive team continues to walk alongside them with encouragement, home visits, and support.

THE DIFFERENCE YOU'RE MAKING IN KENYA


Here are some recent highlights from Kenya—moments of growth, healing, and transformation that your prayers and support are making possible:

- Two new teachers joined Hall Mead School, several others were promoted, and additional security staff were added at Karundas and Hall Mead.
- Renovations at Hall Mead—including classrooms, dining hall, and school gate—gave the campus a fresh look.
- The Karundas Hope Center Clinic re-opened after years of closure, relaunched in April with local leaders and Kids Alive's President in attendance.
- New partnerships with local churches and organizations are strengthening community outreach at Nairobi and Karundas Hope Centers.
- · Guardians across multiple sites participated in trainings and awareness meetings to strengthen families and support children.
- · Children benefitted from participating in various trauma-informed healing practices (child-centered Bible storytelling, healing play sessions, and emotional regulation activities) introduced to staff during Jacaranda Communities of Hope training.
- · Academic clinics, weekly counseling sessions, and mentorship programs at Hall Mead and Karundas boosted learning, confidence, and spiritual growth.
- · Students celebrated milestones, including kindergarten graduation into grade one and the registration of Hall Mead's new grade 9 class.

Because of your support, children in Kenya are learning in safe classrooms, receiving daily care for their health, and building strong foundations of faith. Most importantly, they are discovering that they are cherished and full of purpose. Thank you for helping children step into brighter futures—where education opens doors, families find strength, and every child knows they are deeply loved.

Tamara Found Safety and Courage

When Tamara* came to Kids Alive Zambia at just eight years old, she was deeply wounded. While her mother was hospitalized, Tamara suffered sexual abuse at the hands of the very person who should have protected her—her father. The trauma left her withdrawn, tearful, and afraid.

But when Tamara arrived at Kids Alive, everything began to change. She was welcomed into a place of safety where she could begin to heal. Through consistent therapy, group counseling, and encouragement from caring staff, she slowly regained her voice and her confidence. As part of her healing journey, the Kids Alive team walked closely with her through the difficult legal process, preparing her for court and helping her understand her role. When the time came, Tamara courageously

told the truth—bringing accountability and justice.

Today, Tamara is thriving. She is back in school, doing well academically, and surrounded by friends who remind her she is not alone. She is rediscovering what it means to be cherished, chosen, and deeply loved. Soon she will be reunited with her mother and siblings, this time with renewed hope and a foundation for the future.

Tamara's journey is a powerful reminder of how justice that heals begins with safety, truth, and love. Because of your support, children like Tamara find protection, healing from trauma, and the courage to believe in

brighter days ahead.

WHAT'S HAPPENING IN ZAMBIA

Here are some recent highlights from Zambia—examples of how your prayers and support are changing lives:

- Kids Alive supported the renovation of a cell block at Kabwe Maximum Correctional Facility. Bathrooms and toilets were upgraded for better hygiene, windows widened for ventilation, rooms painted in bright colors, and a television provided—creating a healthier and more hopeful environment.
- Twelve correctional officers from several facilities were trained in Trust-Based Relational Intervention (TBRI), giving them new skills to facilitate better care for young children living with their incarcerated mothers.
- · Community football tournaments brought families and neighbors together to talk about children's rights, break the silence around abuse, and encourage reporting so children can be protected.
- The Scripture Union Youth Camp gathered 264 young people, including nine children from the Keeping Families Together program. The camp created lasting memories and helped participants grow spiritually.
- · Twenty-three parents in Lusaka participated in a two-day TBRI training, learning practical ways to build trust and stronger relationships with their children.
- Students at Kids Alive Academy showcased their talents in the National Schools Arts Association of Zambia. gaining confidence and winning provincial awards in poetry, fine art, and sculpture.
- Parents of students at Kids Alive Academy completed an eight-month tailoring program, with 15 mothers graduating and 90% already earning income through their new skills. A new training group begins soon.
- Children from Lilato and Mongu programs enjoyed a fun day of Bible quizzes, spelling bees, and sports, organized in partnership with a local nonprofit.
- · Children at Chikondi enjoyed a recreational outing to Kalimba Farms, where they learned about animals, played games, and took part in outdoor activities.



Yale's Life Was Built on a Foundation of Faith and Purpose

Yale was just four years old when he arrived at Casa Monte Plata, one of Kids Alive's protective care programs in the Dominican Republic. "It was a really rainy day," he remembers. "It felt dark and tense to me, like something heavy was happening." That heaviness reflected his early childhood—years marked by grief and instability after losing his mother and living with a father who could not safely care for him.


He recalls one night when, alone with his baby brother, "The house wasn't secure," he says. "I just kept crying."

When his father released him and his brother into protective care, their lives shifted. "Thanks to God's perfect will," Yale says, "[my brother and I] were able to arrive at Casa Monte Plata."

From the start, he experienced something different. "I realized I was in a secure place. It was a different kind of happiness than I had known before. A clean happiness. An organized happiness. Something real." At Casa Monte Plata, Yale received consistent care, daily devotions, nutritious

food, and the love of house parents. He was enrolled at Eva May Russell School, where his needs were met holistically—academic, physical, emotional, and spiritual.

The most powerful change came through God's Word. "I used to hear about God at church, at school, at Casa Monte Plata," Yale says. "When I was nine, I remember going into my room alone and praying for the first time. That was the moment I gave my life to Him."



From then on, his life had a new direction.

"God has been modifying and preparing my life for new things," he explains. "Every stage brings a new challenge. I have to learn new things—and leave other things behind. But God is always working in the lives of His children."

With support from Kids Alive, Yale pursued his dream of becoming a lawyer. A scholarship made it possible for him to attend university, and he moved into Casa Esther, the transition home where young adults prepare for independence. During the pandemic, when church services paused,

Yale even stepped up to lead devotions for the children at Casa Monte Plata.

After years of perseverance, Yale graduated in March 2025 with a law degree. "I want to work with children's cases," he says. "I want to be a Christian example in the workforce."

Reflecting on his journey, Yale doesn't hesitate. "If it weren't for Kids Alive—and through it, getting to know God—I would be lost. I'd be living for my own desires, in a completely disorganized life. But today, God gave me something real. And I want to give that love to others."

This fall, Social Services Coordinator Alexandra has started a small group for older girls (grades 7–9), focusing on life skills like cooking, needlepoint, and home care. The school is also launching a dental hygiene program to teach students basic oral care and help parents support their children's hygiene at home.

Our after-school outreach to youth (grades 10–12) will remain strong and fruitful in connecting students to Christ and community.



107 boys and young men from this challenged barrio are participating in Kids Alive's after-school baseball program in Constanza this fall, led by five coaches.

After-School Sports HIGHLIGHT:

- Currently, after-school sports at Kids Alive DR engage more than 700 children and youth across the country, providing structured, team-based activities that promote physical health, character development, and consistent school attendance.
- Constanza Baseball: The after-school baseball program in Constanza is preparing to expand. This summer, funding was secured to purchase land for the development of a new baseball field—an important step toward increasing access for youth in the community. This fall, over 100 young men are participating in the baseball program led by 5 coaches.

SANTO DOMINGO NORTH SCHOOL

Expanded to 7th Grade

At the request of the Dominican Ministry of Education, Santo Domingo North has expanded its academic offerings to include 7th grade, an amazing opportunity for students to remain in the holistic care and faith-based environment of the school. Over the summer, school co-director Margaret attended a training in Guatemala for Trust-Based Relational Intervention, while the teaching staff took part in regional trainings through Association of Christian Schools International—both significant steps toward strengthening the educational and spiritual impact of the school.

Daniel and Mateo Found the Love of a Family For Daniel* and Mateo*, childhood began with one of the deepest wounds a child can carry—their mother left and never came back. With different fathers who were never present, the boys were left without protection, stability, or the love of a family to walk with them as they grew.

The absence of their parents left deep scars. Daniel, the older brother, carried anger, sadness, and feelings of rejection. Mateo, still so young, felt the emptiness of life without a parent's embrace. Both desperately needed a safe place to heal and rediscover hope.

That's when Kids Alive Peru, through The Orchard Children's Home, stepped into their story. Here, they found more than food and shelter-they experienced education, emotional care, and the love of caregivers who reminded them they were not forgotten. Over time, they began to leave behind the wounds of abandonment and discovered that God could give them a new life filled with purpose.

In the midst of this journey, one person became their anchor: Mrs. Isabel Saboya. From the time the boys were young, she was their "mom at heart," faithfully caring for them as if they were her own. Their deepest wish was to belong to her family. In letters full of honesty and tenderness, they wrote of their dream: "to belong to a home with her."

In June 2025, that dream finally came true. Isabel and her husband Lucas welcomed Daniel and Mateo into their home, becoming "Mom Isabel" and "Dad Lucas." It was more than gaining a roof over their heads—they gained a family. A place to belong. A home where they would never be alone again.

Today, the transformation is clear. Daniel, now 17, has completed high school and technical training and is preparing for higher education. Mateo is thriving in his first year of high school, full of excitement and security. Together, they now live with love, stability, and the certainty of a hopeful future.

WHAT'S HAPPENING IN PERU

Across Peru, children and families are experiencing safety, healing, education, and spiritual growth through Kids Alive's homes, hope centers, and family programs. Thanks to your prayers and support, here are some of the recent milestones and highlights that are shaping lives with hope:

- New staff members joined the team, including Attorney Nilo Taype in Andahuaylas, who monitors reintegrated children and leads prevention workshops, and Psychologist Stefany Chumbes at The Lighthouse, who supports survivors of violence and provides emotional care for staff.
- Facility improvements were made across children's homes through donor support, and water filters were
 installed at The Orchard with the help of an NGO—giving families clean drinking water without the need for
 boiling.
- Community protection efforts grew stronger through the implementation of a Response Pathway for cases of violence at The Lighthouse, and through learning and awareness events with justice leaders, the Ministry of Women, and international partners.
- Educational achievements included Mariela (pseudonym), a graduate of Juniper Tree Children's Home, earning the prestigious Beca 18 government scholarship. She is now in her second semester of university studies in psychology.
- Family strengthening programs at The Orchard and Juniper Tree created safe spaces for families to learn emotional tools, improve communication, and grow in resilience.
- Emotional healing programs like Balm of Tenderness and The Voice of My Heart continued to bring hope and restoration to children and families processing past trauma.

Mia is Learning She's Never Alone At just 16 years old, Mia* has already walked through more hardship than most adults. Abandoned by her parents and passed between unsafe homes with sexual abuse, she grew up surrounded by instability, violence, and broken trust. Each move left new scars, and for years she carried the deep ache of loneliness. "Even though I am surrounded by many people, at night I feel alone," she shared quietly with Kids Alive staff.

When Mia arrived at Oasis, Kids Alive Guatemala's protective care program for girls, she found something different—safety, stability, and people who truly listened. For the first time, she began to feel that her life could be rebuilt with hope. Through the care of her psychologist, mentors, and teachers, Mia started learning how to regulate her emotions, grow in confidence, and believe she had a future worth pursuing.

But the most powerful change has come spiritually. With encouragement from staff, Mia created her own devotional rhythm—time for praise, thanksgiving, prayer, and listening to God's Word. Slowly, her latenight loneliness began to give way to a

new awareness of God's presence. "In each devotional I prepare, I feel God's closeness," she says.

Mia's growth hasn't stopped with her personal faith. Today, she is a leader. As part of Oasis's devotional leadership team, she helps plan and guide worship for the other girls. She has led worship on her own and even preached her first sermon—something she never would have imagined just a few years ago.

Instead of being defined by abandonment, Mia is stepping into her identity as God's beloved child. She is building a future filled with courage, faith, and leadership.

- Education expansion at Oasis The former team-house has been renovated into a new education center, now
 hosting morning classes and afternoon tutoring. The improved classrooms provide personalized support and

- Regional leadership Kids Alive Guatemala staff presented at the Christian Alliance for Orphans Latin America Conference, leading panel discussions, teaching workshops on justice that heals, bonds that mend, and promoting foster family care.
- Partnership with the government Kids Alive Guatemala renewed a five-year memorandum of understanding to collaborate in placing children from children's homes into safe, loving foster families each year.
- Survivor Network milestone The Survivor Network in Escuintla marked its first anniversary with a celebration for survivors of sexual violence and their families. The growing group is providing safe spaces for healing, restoration, and flourishing.
- Casa Ester expansion Two new sensory rooms were completed, and a second-floor construction is nearing completion to provide additional offices, meeting spaces, and areas for young women with cognitive disabilities who have experienced sexual violence to grow and thrive.
